The mission of the Parrot Heads of Port Aransas, a not for profit organization, is to assist organizations that support various community needs and environmental concerns. Our 2018 fall fund raiser focuses on two charities that bring that mission home.

VFW 8967 Care and Share Program provides assistance each year to Port Aransas residents and helps support the Fisher House in San Antonio. Fisher House is a facility where families can stay for free while visiting service personnel receiving medical care in San Antonio. Local support includes the annual Christmas food baskets, EMS Toy Round-Up, High School Scholarships, Essay and Art contest at the schools, assisting local vets with food, shelter, clothing and medical expense. Also supported is the School Nursing Fund and a monthly evening meal at the USCG station in Port Aransas.

The Amos Rehabilitation Keep (ARK) specializes in the rescue and recovery of marine turtles and birds of the South Texas Coast and is the only facility that will travel to rescue the animals. Fund raising goes to support the operating expenses of the ARK that include educational outreach programs to the many visitors to Port Aransas.

We are planning and sponsoring our annual fall fundraising event, “Wings Over Port Aransas – Party at the End of the Island” the weekend of October 12 & 13, 2018. All proceeds raised during this event will be equally shared by the VFW and ARK. If you or your business is interested in donating to the event, we would greatly appreciate your help.
